

SERMON NOTES
“In The Shelter of The Most High” | Pastor Matthew Ruttan
May 24, 2020 – Westminster Church, Barrie – Live Stream

This sermon takes us through the well-known and much-cherished Psalm 91. Old Testament commentator Derek Kidner has said, “This is a psalm for danger: for times of exposure and encirclement or of challenging the power of evil.”

2. Here are the five questions that go along with the sermon. Fill them in as you are listening, or later when you’ve had more time to think about them. This psalm and this exercise will help us live “in the shelter of the Most High” and “rest in the shadow of the Almighty” (verse 1).

How do you seek closeness with God on a daily basis?

Verses 3-4

What personal and private thoughts and challenges do you need to talk to God about?

Verses 5-8

How does God’s care for you make you less fearful?

Verses 9-13

As a part of Jesus’ body, how do you benefit from his supreme faithfulness to God?

Verses 14-16

As you ‘hold fast’ to God in loyalty and love, how do you acknowledge him in your life?
